Re: Master Site Codes

Dear Counsel:

This letter contains two major changes you will need to be aware of:

1) Master Sites

On Sunday, January 13th, we added the concept of Master Sites and site Aliases to Trust Online. All exposure sites will now have a "Master" site code that begins with "M". This code will be the connection between all related sites. This new functionality enables us to create a Master Site for the physical location and Aliases for each of the individual site codes for each of the Trusts. The system will now match any of the related site codes (Master or any of the Aliases) and will treat them equally. Therefore, if you use a B&W site code on a USG claim, the system will treat it in exactly the same way as if you had used the USG site code. Below is an example of the new site picker:

In order to distinguish between an Approved Site for a specific Trust and the Master Site, Master Sites are prefixed with the letter "M". This change does not require you to use Master Site codes because the Approved Site codes for each Trust are still accepted.

Note: This does not change how you enter the Approved Site code on the claim. This only changes how Trust Online treats the Approved Site code and any linked claims that may be affected.

2) Administrative Settlement fields on OC and FB litigation page

There are new fields on the litigation page for OC and FB to allow you to enter administrative settlement information. This information will be used in calculating potential SOL tolling dates.
